The Government of Nepal [GoN] has allocated funds towards the cost of Construction of Stone Pavement and Allied Works at Pashupati Area under the Bagmati Area Physical Infrastructure Development Project (BAPIDP) and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for Construction of Stone Pavement and Allied Works at Pashupati Area under the Bagmati Area Physical Infrastructure Development Project (BAPIDP) (Contract No: BAPIDP-PA1-074/75). Bidding is open to all eligible bidders as per Section V of Bidding Document
2. High Powered Committee for Integrated Development of The Bagmati Civilization invites electronic bids from eligible bidders for the construction of Stone Pavement, foot path, side drain and allied works under National Competitive Bidding – Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding procedures.

Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover of the best 3 years within the last 10 years: Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover of NRs. 125 Million, calculated as total certified payments received for construction contracts in progress or completed, within best 3 years out of last 10 years.

For Single Entity: Must Meet Requirement

For Joint Venture:

All Partners Combined: Must Meet Requirement

Each Partner: Must meet 40% of the requirement

One Partner: Must meet 50% of the requirement

Minimum Work experience of similar size and nature: Participation as Prime contractor, management contractor, or sub contractor in at least 2(Two) contracts within the last 10 years, each with the value of at least NRs. 56 Million

3. Under the Single Stage, Two Envelope Procedure, Bidders are required to submit simultaneously two separate sealed envelopes, one containing (i) the Technical Bid and the other (ii) the Price Bid, both in turn enclosed in one sealed envelope as per the provision of ITB 21 of the Bidding Document.

7. Sealed or electronic bids must be submitted to the office High Powered Committee for Integrated Development of The Bagmati Civilization, Kathmandu, Kathmandu, Kathmandu, Nepal by hand/courier or through PPMO's e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before 26-02-2018 12:00. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
8. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 26-02-2018 13:00 hours at the office of High Powered Committee for Integrated Development of The Bagmati Civilization, Guheshwori, Kathmandu, Nepal. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of NRs. 1700000 which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
9. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
